We, the undersigned, hereby declare that I/We have read and fully understood all the policies and regulations of Mount Olive Hostel and Douglas Memorial Higher Secondary School, Barrackpore. I/We agree to abide by these policies and regulations, including but not limited to the following:

- ♦ **Withdrawal/Expulsion Policy:**

- ♦ If a child is withdrawn or expelled from the school, they will also be deemed withdrawn from the hostel.
- ♦ The hostel admission fee, annual fee, and any other fee paid at the time of admission will be forfeited.
- ♦ Parents intending to withdraw their ward(s) from the hostel at any point must clear the full year's hostel fee.
- ♦ **After withdrawal, rejoining will require fresh admission.**
- ♦ Submitting an application does not guarantee the student will be shifted from the hostel to the day school; the Principal's decision will be final and binding.
- ♦ Students enrolled as full boarders at the time of admission will not be converted into weekly boarders during the current session.
- ♦ However, the appropriate authority may permit a full boarder to become a weekly boarder on medical or other sufficient grounds.
 - No hostel student will be permitted to leave the hostel and stay in a private paying guest (PG) accommodation while attending school. If a student needs to leave the hostel, they must stay only with their parents or an approved local guardian. This policy ensures the safety, well-being, and proper supervision of all students.

- ♦ **Behavior and Conduct:**

- ♦ Students involved in fights, consumption of drugs/alcohol, or stealing will result in automatic expulsion.
- ♦ Students who do not benefit from the school or make little progress may be asked to leave.
- ♦ Boarders caught cheating, bullying, or bringing disrepute to the school through behaviour deemed unacceptable will be expelled. The Principal's decision in these matters is final.
